Osgood Ladies League Game Descriptions 2010

Scramble

Take the best shot from the team until the ball is holed. One team score is recorded.

Scramble Off The Tee

Take the best drive and all drop their balls at this point. Each player continues until their individual ball is holed. Each player records a score.

Special Scramble

Play a scramble but observe the rules assigned by the proshop before play. Examples of special rules are: each team must designate whose drive will be taken before it is hit, etc.

On-Course Events

24 Events are placed throughout the course. Events include: longest drive, shortest drive, closest to the pin, closest to the hole, closest to the water, etc. Sign the signs accordingly.

Golf Bingo

Each golfer plays their own ball or a scramble depending of the rules. Cross off on the team scorecard when a player completes one of the squares. **YOU MAY ONLY CROSS OFF ONE SQUARE PER HOLE.** Black-out bingo is the best.

Don't Lose the Pink Ball

Play a scramble. Each team is assigned pink golf balls. These balls must be in play at all times and rotated by hole between the players. Place an X on the scorecard when a pink ball is lost. Teams that bring both balls back to the pro-shop have a better chance of winning.
